IF A FLOOD WARNING IS ISSUED:

Move your car to a safe place

Charge your mobile

Pack a bag ready to evacuate (see "Have a flood plan")

Be ready to turn off gas, electric, water

Put your flood defences in place

Block sink, baths, toilets, washing machines, dishwashers etc.

If possible, move valuables, electrical items and important documents to the first floor

Move or raise furniture

Take pets to safety

Take a list of important contacts

Take photos to create a timeline of events

Follow advice from the EA, Emergency Services and the Emergency Volunteers
